## 30 YEAR HISTORY

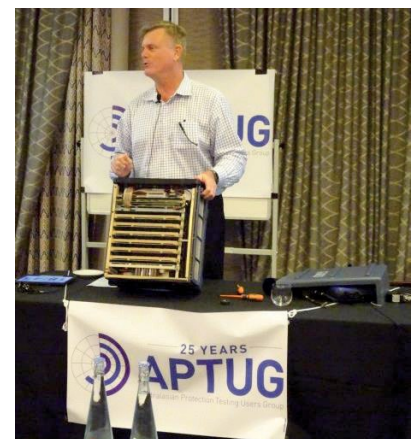
